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in a retelling of the classic french fairy tale east of the sun west of the moon camille the daughter of a poor crofter is forced to wed a mysterious prince in exchange for wealth for her family

book jacket status jacketed introduction by peter washington translation by william weaver italo calvino s masterpiece combines a love story and a detective story into an exhilarating allegory of reading in which the reader of the book becomes the book s central character based on a witty analogy between the reader s desire to finish the

story and the lover's desire to consummate his or her passion if on a winter's night a traveler is the tale of two bemused readers whose attempts to reach the end of the same book if on a winter's night a traveler by Italo Calvino of course are constantly and comically frustrated in between chasing missing chapters of the book the hapless readers tangle with an international conspiracy a rogue translator an elusive novelist a disintegrating publishing house and several oppressive governments the result is a literary labyrinth of storylines that interrupt one another an Arabian Nights of the postmodern age

a beautiful hardback edition of Calvino's genre switching masterwork a book of surprise and adventure but you the reader are the hero you go into a bookshop and buy if on a winter's night a traveller by Italo Calvino you like it but alas there is a printer's error in your copy you take it back to the shop and get a replacement but the replacement seems to be a totally different story you try to track down the original book you were reading but end up with a different narrative again this remarkable novel leads you through many different books including a detective adventure a romance a satire an erotic story a diary and a quest but the real hero is you the reader breathtakingly inventive David Mitchell a writer of dizzying ambition and variety each of his stories is a fresh adventure into the possibilities of fiction guardian vintage quarterbound classics bound to be beautiful
